## Before his fall

- **I.** Your spiritual enemy is a formidable, ferocious foe.
  - 1. Satan rules his earthly kingdoms through demons—fallen angels.
  - 2. He has supernatural powers.
  - 3. He cannot touch the Christian; however he can put thoughts in your mind.
  - 4. He can manipulate circumstances.
  - 5. He can control the weather.
  - 6. He can use the unsaved and carnal Christians in his plan to thwart those who desire to serve God.
  - 7. His methods are generally misunderstood.
- **II.** How Satan is addressed in Scripture.
  - 1. Satan's manipulation of humans is addressed by God through that third person—a foil (Mt. 16:20-23).
  - 2. Satan rules the world system (Mt. 4:8-9; Lu. 4:5-6).
  - 3. He was the authority behind the King of Tyre (Ez. 28-11-19).
    - 1) A cherub (v. 14).
    - 2) Created (vv. 13, 15).
    - 3) Perfect—sum total (vv. 12, 15).
    - 4) Brightness (v. 17 cf. Is. 14:12; 2 Cor. 11:14).
- **III.** Lucifer before he changed to the enemy of God (Ez. 28:11-19).
  - 1. God prepared a special place for Lucifer, bright-star, to rule the universe: Eden the Garden of God (v. 13-14).
    - 1) The Garden had precious stones (v. 13).
    - 2) Lucifer was "a setting" for the stones (v. 13).
    - 3) The stones interacted with Lucifer v. 14).
  - 2. Lucifer was the sum total of "well arranged" (v. 12).
  - 3. He was perfect in his activities of life—his governing (v. 15).
    - 1) Holy mountain belonging to God (v. 14, 16).
    - 2) "Covereth," overshadowed all in in the kingdom.
  - 4. He was full of wisdom—used information correctly (v. 12).
  - 5. He was created the sum total of beauty (vv. 12, 17).
  - 6. He was the articular head of the government (V. 14, 16).
  - 7. He was anointed—special relationship to the Holy Spirit (v.14).
