The Second Seal is opened

- **I.** The Day of the Lord is a time of God's wrath (Zeph. 1:7, 14-15; Rev. 6:16).
 - 1. Begins after the Rapture (1 Thes. chapter 4 cf. chapter 5).
 - 2. Begins with a false peace (1 Thes. 5:3).
 - 3. Comes without expectation, suddenly as a thief in the night (1 Thes. 5:2-4).
 - 4. Will bring great pain and destruction (1 Thes. 5:3; Mt. 24:6, 8).
 - 5. Like birth pangs there is more to come.
 - 6. The Day of the Lord begins after the majority of Jews return to the Land (Dan. 9:24).
 - 7. The Day of the Lord begins with the seven year peace covenant (Dan. (9:27).
 - 1) Protecting Israel (Ez. 38:11).
 - 2) Very short time of peace (1 Thes. 5:3).
- **II.** The Second Seal is opened (Rev. 6:3).
 - 1. One of the four living creatures, cherubim one of the "Praetorian Guard" (Rev. 6:1; 4:6-8; Ez. 10:4, 14-15).
 - 2. The red horse represents the condition of war, first war during the Tribulation (Rev. 6:4).
 - 3. The rider characterizes power to violently destroy his enemies
- **III.** The image of Daniel chapter 2: first four forms of world governments.
 - 1. The image Nebuchadnezzar forgot (Dan. 2:31-35 901).
 - 2. The interpretation of the image (Dan. 2:37-45).
 - 1) 1st Head of gold = Nebuchadnezzar (v. 37).
 - 2) 2nd Torso of silver is inferior (v. 39a).
 - 3) 3rd Lower torso of brass (v. 39b).
 - 4) 4th legs of iron (v. 40).
 - 5) 5TH the feet of mixed iron and clay (v. 41-42).
- **IV.** The fifth form of world government seen in the image comes out of the forth form (Dan. 2:41-43).
 - 1. Strength of iron (v. 41 cf. 4th kingdom).
 - 2. Mixture of brittle clay and iron (v. 41).
 - 3. The toes (10) are brittle.
 - 4. The 10 kingdoms' brittleness is the result of mixing common men with royalty.
 - 1) Inner confederacy rivalry.
 - 2) Like mixture of clay and iron.

- **V.** The beasts of Daniel chapter 7: the first four forms of world governments—Daniel's four beasts (Dan. 7:4-7, 9, 17).
 - 1. 1st beast a Lion—fierce, strong, quick = Nebuchadnezzar (v.4).
 - 2. 2nd beast a Bear—lopsided partnership = Medo-Persian empire (v. 5; *cf.* 8:21).
 - 3. 3rd beast a Leopard— dominate, fast, four generals = Greece (v. 6, 6:32; *cf.* 8:21).
 - 4. 4th beast has great iron teeth—strong, divided kingdom = Roman Empire (v. 7, 23).
- **VI.** The fifth form comes out of the fourth beast (Dan. 7:7).
 - 1. Ten horns are ten kings, the fifth form (v.24; Rev. 17:12-13).
 - 2. The 10 king confederation will be arranged by the man of sin before he is well known (Dan. 9:26-27).
 - 3. Three kings rebel and are destroyed by the seven kings and the man of sin (Dan. 7:8; 9:24).
 - 4. This war occurs during the first half of the Tribulation (Mt. 24:6-7).
