The Tower of Babel

- I. Conditions after the Flood.
 - 1. The heavens were changed.
 - 1) The climate was different.
 - 2) The stars were now distinct (Job 22:13-16; 26:5-11).
 - i. Angels make their home on stars (Is. 40:22-26; 45:18; Ps. 33:6; Eph. 6:12 *cf*. Is. 66:1; Job 1:6; 2:1).
 - ii. Fallen angels hybridized humans before the Flood (2 Pet. 2:4-5).
 - iii. The source of the giants came from the stars.
 - 2. There was one land-mass, Pangea (Gen. 1:9).
 - 3. There was one language (Gen. 11:1).
 - 4. There were families, or tribes, nations are after Abraham.
- **II.** The Rebellion against God of the people.
 - 1. They built cities (Gen. 10:11,12; 11:4, 8).
 - 2. Wanted to be one people: name (Gen. 11:4).
 - 3. Refused to spread out over the land.
 - 4. They worshiped the stars and the gods they represented (Gen. 11:4), "... let us build a city with a tower whose top with the heavens ..." (Rom. 1:23; Exam. Acts 7:41-43).
 - 5. They changed creation into creators: birds, quadrupeds, and reptiles.
 - 6. They worshiped the gods represented by the constellations in the heavens, whence they came before the Flood.
- **III.** God's judgment since the people would not spread out and so quickly constructed false gods.
 - 1. God gives a warning to Noah? Eber? Peleg? (Gen 11:5-6).
 - 2. God confuses the language (Gen. 11:7).
 - 3. This causes them to spread out on the land (Gen. 11:8-9).
 - 4. God divides the land-mass (Gen. 10:25).
 - 5. The continents drift apart rapidly, during Peleg's lifetime: 259 years (Gen. 10:25).
