The Church at Laodicea, the Fake Church

Rev. 3:14-21

- **I.** Laodicea: lao = people, dica = rights, justice—people's justice.
 - 1. The people have the ability to define morality, God.
 - 2. Represents most of today's Christendom, aka Christedumb.
- II. Laodicea's judgment measured by their works.
 - 1. The destination of a person is determined not by works, but rather whether or not their name is in the Book of the Life (Rev. 20:11-15).
 - 2. The degree of punishment, or reward, is determined by works (1 Cor. 3:12-15).
 - 3. Not hot or cold, lukewarm; they have no defining character.
 - 1) They absorb, amalgamate all 'Christian' belief systems.
 - 2) "You are entitled to your point of view."
 - 4. Because of their lack of Christian character, Christ is about to spit them out of His mouth.
- **III.** Descriptions of the collective unsaved state of this church.
 - 1. Not hot or cold.
 - 2. Christ will spit them out of His mouth.
 - 3. They are physically rich, so their deficiencies are in the spiritual realm.
 - Wretched (cf. Rom. 7:24).
 - Miserable, pitiful (cf. 1 Cor. 15:19).
 - Poor (cf. Col. 1:27).
 - Blind (cf. 2 Cor. 4:4).
 - Naked (cf. Gal. 3:27).
 - 4. Christ is not even fond of them since He will not child train or rebuke them v. 19. "If how many as I might be fond of, I rebuke and I child train..." (This is a third-class condition clause and suggests a remote possibility.)
