

The Seven Sayings on the Cross, #3

I. The crucifixion timeline on Wednesday.

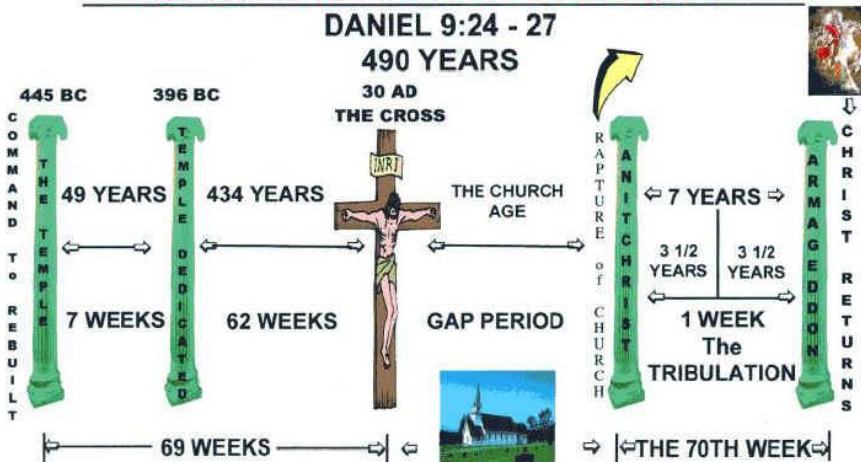
1. Jesus nailed to the cross at 9:00am (Mk. 15:25).
2. The first saying, “forgive them ...”, spread the guilt to the whole world.
3. The second saying, “with Me in paradise ...”, proved salvation is by belief—no works.

II. The third saying, “Woman, behold your son ... Behold your mother” (Jn. 19:26-27).

1. The title nailed on the cross: “THIS IS (Mt. 27:37; Lu. 23:38) JESUS (Mt. 27; Jn. 19:19) OF NAZARETH (Jn. 19:19) THE KING OF THE JEWS” (all, Mk. 15:26): **“This is Jesus of Nazareth the king of the Jews”**.
2. The soldiers fulfill Scripture (Jn. 19:23-24; Ps. 22:18).
3. The bystanders: 1. Mary (mother), 2. Mary’s sister, 3. Mary wife of Cleophas, 4. Mary Magdalene, 5. Apostle John (Jn. 19:25-26).
4. Mary, mother of Jesus.
 - 1) Perfect heritage (Lu. 3:31, 33).
 - 2) Chaste (Mt. 1:18, 23).
 - 3) Right time (Gal. 4:4) 69 weeks of years in Danuel (p. 914).
 - 4) Found ‘favor’ with God (Lu. 1:30, 46-56).
5. “Woman” separating His ministry from family ties (*cf.* Jn. 2:4).
 - 1) From physical relationship to spiritual relationship.
 - 2) Dissolving earthly relationships (Jn. 19:36).
 - 3) “Assigning John to Mary—cutting John’s human bond with Jesus.
 - 4) “I am not your little boy any longer; I am God.
 - 5) “Behold your mother”, assigning Mary to John—providing for the widow by.
 - 6) History of family problems (Mk. 3:21-35; Mt. 13:55-56).
