## **Book of Revelation** part 6

- **I.** To Him is the glory—splendor, majesty, honor (v. 7).
  - 1. He will manifest His power throughout the book.
  - 2. Into the ages from an age (Eph. 3:9-10, 21; Eph. 2:7).
  - 3. Look! He is coming associated with the clouds (v. 7).
    - 1) "Glory" clouds (Ps. 104:1-2; 1 Tim. 6:16).
    - 2) The clouds of the Heaven (Dan. 7:13; Mt. 24:30).
  - 4. And every eye shall see Him and they which pierced Him (Mt. 24:30; Ps. 22:16; Zech. 12:10; Jn. 19:34, 37).
  - 5. All the tribes of the earth shall beat themselves in mourning because of Him (Mt. 24:30).
  - 6. Even so.
  - 7. Truly.
- II. The Alpha and Omega,  $\mathbf{A} \ \& \ \Omega \ (v.\ 8)$ .
  - 1. Εγώ είμι, I AM, the great I AM (Ex. 3:14; Ps. 90:2; Is. 57:15; Jn. 8:58).
  - 2. Alpha and Omega (Jn.1:1, 14; Rev. 21:6; 22:13).
    - 1) "logos": account treatise, discourse, thesis, etc.
    - 2) At this point, Christ is the source, means, and sum total of written revelatory information regarding both prophesy and future judgment (*cf.* Jn 5:22).
    - 3) Christ is the final Word.
  - 3. The beginning and the ending (cf. 21:6).
    - 1) Of judgment.
    - 2) The Rapture to the Great White Throne Judgment.
  - 4. The Lord God.
    - 1) Sovereign deity.
    - 2) In a human body.
  - 5. The One who is, and the One who was always existing, and the One who is coming.
    - 1) The One who exists in the present.
    - 2) The One who exists in the past.
    - 3) The One who's coming is going to occur (cf. v. 4).
  - 6. Almighty—absolute and universal sovereign power: omnipotent.
    - 1) Inexhaustible inherent power.
    - 2) Only limited by what is contrary to the Divine nature.
